

EU DECLARATION OF PACKAGING COMPLIANCE

NAREX Žďánice, spol. s r.o. hereby issues this Declaration of Packaging Compliance under its sole responsibility.

1.) Manufacturer Information

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2.) Subject of the Declaration

This declaration applies to the packaging materials used by NAREX Žďánice, spol. s r.o. for the packaging, storage, handling and transportation of manufactured products.

The packaging materials are designed and used to meet the requirements for product protection, safe handling and transportation, efficient use of materials and support for recycling at the end of their life cycle.

Plastic boxes supplied together with taps are intended for their long-term storage, protection and organization during use and, within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR), are not considered packaging but a part of the product itself (a case). These items are not included within the scope of this Declaration of Packaging Compliance, and their classification and assessment of compliance with the PPWR are addressed in a separate document entitled 'Declaration on the Classification and Compliance of Plastic Cases for Cutting Tools under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)', which is maintained by NAREX Žďánice, spol. s r.o. as part of its technical documentation.

3.) Identification of Packaging Units

An overview of the packaging materials used and their identification is provided in TABLE 1 on page 2 of this document.

4.) Compliance with Legal Requirements

The company declares that the packaging materials used comply with the requirements of the following legislation:

- Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council on Packaging and Packaging Waste (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation – PPWR);
- Commission Decision 97/129/EC establishing the identification system for packaging materials;
- Act No. 477/2001 Coll., on Packaging, as amended, to the extent applicable to manufacturers and users of packaging in the Czech Republic;
- Related implementing legislation of the European Union and the Czech Republic governing the placing of packaging on the market.

5.) Fulfilment of PPWR Requirements

The company further declares that:

- the weight and volume of packaging materials have been reduced to the minimum necessary while maintaining the required level of product protection and safety during handling, storage and transportation;
- the packaging materials are designed with recyclability and material recovery in mind at the end of their life cycle;
- the packaging materials used are procured from qualified suppliers and are accompanied by the relevant technical documentation;
- the concentration of heavy metals and other regulated substances does not exceed the limits established by applicable European Union legislation;
- technical documentation demonstrating compliance of the packaging materials used is maintained and made available to the competent authorities upon request;
- the packaging materials used support sorting, recycling and the circular economy in line with the objectives of the PPWR.

This statement was prepared based on the technical documentation provided by packaging suppliers, internal specifications, and the company's management system.
